2. Rules for the EMC

Chapter 5: European Championships

5.1 Championship categories

5.1.2 European Men Championships (EMC).

5.2 Age limitations

5.2.1 There is no age limitation for the EWC and the EMC.

5.3 Periods

5.3.2 The EMC is conducted each second year in odd years, preferably in June during weeks 23 and 24.

5.4 Teams

- 5.4.1 Each team consists of maximum 6 players
- 5.4.2 The teams must come from affiliated ETBF federations

5.5 Events

- 5.5.1 The following events exist
 - a) Doubles, 12 games
 - b) Trios, 6 games
 - c) Team, 6 games
 - d) All Event, consisting of the above 24 games
 - e) Masters as specified in 5.5.6 and 5.5.7

5.5.3 Specifications for the Doubles event

- a) The Doubles event qualification will be played in two blocks of six games.
- b) The first block will be played on short oil and the second block on long oil.
- c) The four highest positioned in the Doubles event qualification are qualified for the semi finals, seeded as 1-4 according to the final standing of the Doubles event qualification.
- d) The doubles in the semi finals will be matched as the 1st seeded double vs. the 4th seeded double and the 2nd seeded double vs. the 3rd seeded double.
- e) The winners of the semi finals are qualified for the final, while the highest seeded of the losing doubles will be positioned 3 in the championships and the lowest seeded of the losing doubles will be positioned 4 in the championships.
- f) Both semi finals and the final will be one game matches.
- g) The highest seeded double in each of the three matches will decide whether the match will be played on short oil or on long oil and is also deciding on which lane to begin.

5.5.4 Specifications for the Trios event

a) The Trios event qualification will be played in two blocks of three games.

- b) The first block will be played on short oil and the second block on long oil.
- c) The four highest positioned in the Trios event qualification are qualified for the semi finals, seeded as 1-4 according to the final standing of the Trios event qualification.
- d) The trios in the semi finals will be matched as the 1st seeded trio vs. the 4th seeded trio and the 2nd seeded trio vs. the 3rd seeded trio.
- e) The winners of the semi finals are qualified for the final, while the highest seeded of the losing trios will be positioned 3 in the championships and the lowest seeded of the losing trios will be positioned 4 in the championships.
- f) Both semi finals and the final will be one game matches.
- g) The highest seeded trio in each of the three matches will decide whether the match will be played on short oil or on long oil and is also deciding on which lane to begin.

5.5.5 Specifications for the Team event

- a) The Team event qualification will be played in two blocks of three games.
- b) The first block will be played on short oil and the second block on long oil.
- c) The four highest positioned in the Team event qualification are qualified for the semi finals, seeded as 1-4 according to the final standing of the Team event qualification.
- d) The teams in the semi finals will be matched as the 1st seeded team vs. the 4th seeded team and the 2nd seeded team vs. the 3rd seeded team.
- e) The winners of the semi finals are qualified for the final, while the highest seeded of the losing teams will be positioned 3 in the championships and the lowest seeded of the losing teams will be positioned 4 in the championships.
- f) Both semi finals and the final will be one game matches.
- g) The highest seeded team in each of the three matches will decide whether the match will be played on short oil or on long oil and is also deciding on which lane to begin.

5.5.6 Specifications for the matches of the Masters event

- a) The 24 highest positioned players in the final All Event standing are qualified for the Masters event, seeded as 1-24 in all steps of the Masters event according to their position in the final All Event standing.
- b) In all steps of the Masters event there will head to head matches, where the highest seeded players will be matched against the lowest seeded player.
- c) Each match will consist of 2 or 3 games. If the same player is the winner of the first two games, the 3rd game will not be played.
- d) Each match will be played on one pair of lanes, where the left lane will be dressed with short oil and the right lane with long oil.
- e) Each game in a match will be played on the same lane.
- f) In each match the highest seeded player will decide whether the first game will be played on the left lane or the right lane. The second game will be played on the other lane and an eventually third game at the same lane as the first game.
- g) In each match the highest seeded player is deciding whether he wants to begin the first game or not. In the second game the order of players will be opposite to the first game and in an eventually third game the order of players will be the same as in the first game.
- h) In case of withdrawals from any match in the Masters event, the player without opponent will be declared the winner of the match.

5.5.7 The steps of the Masters event

- a) There will be 8 matches in the Masters event Step 1, including the players seeded 9-24. The winners of the 8 matches will continue to the Masters event Step 2.
- b) There will be 8 matches in the Masters event Step 2, including the players seeded 1-8 plus the 8 winners of the Masters event Step 1. The winners of the 8 matches will continue to the Masters event Step 3.
- c) There will be 4 matches in the Masters event Step 3, including the 8 winners of the Masters event Step 2. The winners of the 4 matches will continue to the Masters event Step 4.
- d) There will be 2 matches in the Masters event Step 4, including the 4 winners of the Masters event Step 3. The winners of the 2 matches will continue to the Masters event Step 5.
- e) There will be 1 match in the Masters event Step 5, including the 2 winners of the Masters event Step 4. The winner of the match is the European Masters Champion.

5.5.8 The final positioning

- a) The winner of the match in the Masters event Step 5 will be positioned as number 1 and the loser of this match as number 2.
- b) The losers of the matches in the Masters event Step 4 will be positioned in the interval 3-4 according to their seeding before the Masters event.
- c) The losers of the matches in the Masters event Step 3 will be positioned in the interval 5-8 according to their seeding before the Masters event.
- d) The losers of the matches in the Masters event Step 2 will be positioned

- in the interval 9-16 according to their seeding before the Masters event.
- e) The losers of the matches in the Masters event Step 1 will be positioned in the interval 17-24 according to their seeding before the Masters event.
- f) The remaining players will be positioned 25-NN according to their scores in the All Event standing.

5.6 Amendments

This Chapter was adopted by the Congress in Moscow, Russia on 2 June 2005 and amended after an email ballot in December 2005.

Championship oil-patterns

In co-operation between the ETBF Presidium and Kegel, which is the official lane maintenance partner for ETBF, a changed procedure for deciding and publishing oil-patterns before championships has been evolved.

The changed procedure is as follows:

- A Technical Delegate from ETBF will inspect the host championship centre 6-12 months prior to a championship. The product of the technical inspection is a technical report.
- 2. Based on the technical report, the ETBF Technical Delegate and Kegel will decide the length of the oil-pattern in single lane condition championships or the length of both oil-patterns in dual lane condition championships.
- 3. In due time before a championship, and latest when the championship bulletin 2 is circulated, the length of the oil-pattern(s) will be published.
- 4. Some days prior to a championship, the amount of oil and profile of the pattern(s) will be decided by the ETBF Technical Delegate and a representative from Kegel at the championship site.
- 5. The oil-pattern(s) will be published latest at the team managers meeting.

The main elements of the changed procedure is, that only the length of the oil-patterns will be published before the championships, while the oil-patterns will be published only shortly before the official practise of a championship. The length of the oil-patterns would be sufficient information for coaches and players to decide which equipment to bring to a championship.

The previous procedure allowed federations, coaches and players to obtain the oil-patterns in advance. These oil-patterns might have been applied with substandard or different lane maintenance equipment, by entirely different chemicals and played and practiced on completely different lane surfaces in different environments. The players practiced at home on the oil-patterns for hours on the same lanes and then they went to the championship centre and played only a few shots on each lane before it was time to switch pairs. Because of all these differences, the oil-patterns will play different at the championship site, than they did back home.

The previously published oil-patterns ahead of time did not explain the different topography of each lane, the friction of the lane surface, the standard of the lane installations in the host championship centre, the centre maintenance or even how good or bad the pin carry may be. All these factors are all equally as important as the oil-patterns.

The changed procedure will eliminate any preconceived notions of how the pattern will play or should be played and it will eliminate the perceived or real advantage of the host players by being able to practice and prepare months in advance in the host championship centre on the announced oil-patterns. By only announcing the length of the oil-patterns, it will in essence create a more level playing field and a more socially acceptable playing environment.

The changed procedure will be in effect as of the first ETBF Championship in 2007, which is the European Youth Championship to be conducted in Thessaloniki, Greece on 6-15 April 2007.
